- 3. The Summer Recreation will be held August 5<sup>th</sup> August 29<sup>th</sup>, Monday thru Thursday 9:00am until Noon for ages 5-12.

4. Light up Livingston, Livingston County received 26-million-dollar funding Grant from the State of NY, The Empire Internet Company to start extending Fiber Optic Cable in some areas in the Town of Springwater.

2. A new camera system and a new secured Wi-Fi system is currently being installed in the Springwater Town Hall.

#### **NEW CONSENT/SEWER PROJECT**

1. Upgrade to Sewer Plant Rating -The Town of Springwater received a letter from the NYS-DEC that they have upgraded the Town of Springwater's Sewer plant from a level one plant to a level two plant. The two-rating plant will require the Town to have grade two operators. The Livingston County Water/ Sewer Authority, Jason Molino, has offered to prepare a formal response to the NYS-DEC on behalf of the Town of Springwater, that the County Authority will act as one of the grade 2 plant operators and the Town of Springwater is in the process of getting the Town's main operator trained as a level two. The Springwater Town Board had no objection for the Livingston County Water/ Sewer Authority to answer on behalf of the Town of Springwater to the NYS-DEC.

<u>Motion</u> made by Supervisor Babbitt Henery to allow Jason Molino from the Livingston County Water/ Sewer Authority to contact NYS-DEC and write the letter on the Town's behalf regarding the grade 2 operator, seconded by Deputy Supervisor Gnau; Roll Call: Councilmember Canute Jr., aye; Councilmember Proctor, aye; Deputy Supervisor Gnau, aye; Supervisor Babbitt Henry, aye; motion carried.

#### **Board Reports**

Town Clerk - Nothing to report.

Councilman Proctor (Recreation, Town Clerk, Planning)- Nothing to report.

Councilman Canute (Water) — Councilman Canute had spoken to the Town Water Department on the scope of work they felt should be done regarding the Water Tank; Canute Jr., also reported, seen on the internet the Town of Springwater has a 30% water loss, an unknown leak some place that is not metered. Some other Towns show a 50% loss.

Councilman Gnau (Sewer) Nothing to report.

Councilman Mason (Fire; Highway) – Highway Superintendent Matt Nisbet spoke, possible Grant to potentially get new plow blades. The Grant would pay 75% to put cameras up around Town to check road surface temperatures and wind speed.

Supervisor Babbitt Henry asked if anyone would like to speak regarding the public hearing. Deputy Supervisor Gnau questioned the process on handling the Grant Application. A discussion with the Town Board on putting a proposal out for a Grant Administrator to administer the process, the qualified list will be sent to the Town of Springwater and approved by the board.
