4. A discussion with Board Members on waiving the amount owed from the Fire District to the Town of Springwater from the 2024 Budget issue in the amount of \$17,733.00 to the Town of Springwater.

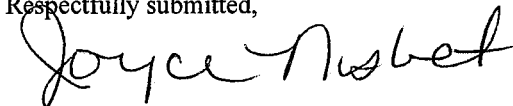
